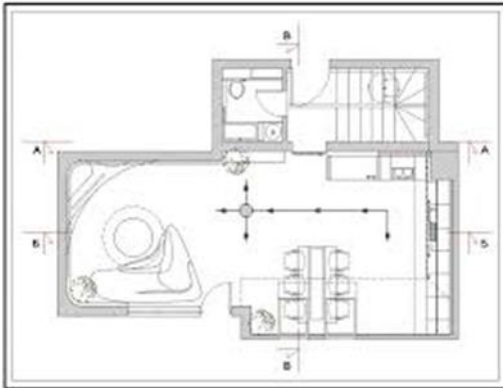


Interior Design

Course Description

This laboratory course teaches students to use knowledge and skills related to interior and exterior environments, construction, and furnishings to compete in industry, increase productivity and make wise consumer decisions.
