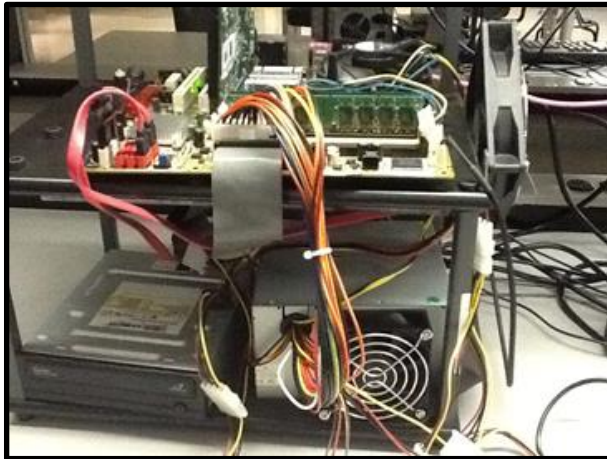


Computer Maintenance
