Scope of Work: Data Infrastructure Move

- 1.0 Needham ES MDF Relocation:
 - 1.1 Test the (3) existing 6-strand OM1 Multi Mode fiber optic cables that run from the existing MDF location to each of three IDF locations, IDF B, IDF C and IDF D to confirm all strands are currently working.
 - 1.2 Remove the 2-post rack and all equipment in the existing MDF and re-install at the newly designated MDF location.
 - 1.3 Provide and Install new 12" ladder rack from the wall to the top of the 2-post rack in the new IDF for routing cables.
 - 1.4 Back pull (3) existing 25 Pair copper cables from the existing MDF location to the new MDF location and re-terminate in the new MDF location.
 - 1.5 Back pull (3) existing 6-strand OM1 Multi Mode fiber optic cables from the existing MDF location to the new MDF location and re-terminate in the new MDF location.
 - 1.6 25 pair cables shall be punched down to existing 110-rackmount block (moved from old MDF).
 - 1.7 New fiber connectors shall be provided for existing OM1 fiber cables at the new MDF side. There is a total of 18 fiber terminations.
 - 1.8 Provide & Install (5) new runs of Category 5e for new phone lines at the designated locations per the site visit.
 - 1.9 Label, test, and certify all copper and fiber terminations and provide test records at job close out.
 - 1.10 Provide 60A subpanel in new MDF room.
 - 1.11 Install (2) 30A Receptacles.
 - 1.12 Provide and install (1) new 6-strand OM1 Multi fiber optic cable and (1) new 50 pair Cat 3 copper cable from the existing MDF location to the new MDF location. Terminate, test and label all cables.
- 2.0 Needham ES Boring AT&T and Comcast Pathway to Utility Pole (See drawing #1370, dated 2/5/2019):
 - 2.1 Provide and install (1) 3" AT&T and (1) 2" Comcast conduit from the existing utility pole on Chestnut Street to the MDF location inside Needham ES.
 - 2.2 Direction bore from the utility pole on Chestnut Street to utility vaults near the cafeteria building, (1) vault for AT&T and (1) vault for Comcast.
 - 2.3 Provide and install (1) 3" AT&T conduit from the new AT&T utility vault to the new MDF location by installing the new conduit on the underside of the existing walkway canopy. Comply with all AT&T design requirements and criteria.
 - 2.4 Provide and install (1) 2" Comcast conduit from the new Comcast utility vault to the new MDF location by installing the new conduit on the underside of the existing walkway canopy. Comply with all Comcast design requirements and criteria.

- 2.5 Provide required underground and above ground pull boxes, fittings, and elbows as required.
- 2.6 Provide #6 ground and telecommunications ground bus bar at backboard in new MDF.
- 2.7 Provide encroachment permit and cover all city fees.
- 2.8 Return any areas disturbed by construction to its original condition.
- 2.9 Provide alternate cost #1 for routing of the AT&T and Comcast conduits from the first Utility vaults via directional boring to a second set of utility vaults outside the new MDF location as shown on the drawing.
- 3.0 Needham ES Data Cabling 9 Portables (See drawing #1370, dated 2/5/2019):
 - 3.1 Provide and install (6) 2" conduits from the new MDF/IDF location to a new pull box in the planter.
 - 3.2 Provide and install (3) 2" conduits from the new planter pull box to portable 18 to feed the row of (4) portables.
 - 3.3 Provide and install (4) 2" conduits from the new planter pull box to portable 19 to feed the row of (5) portables.
 - 3.4 Provide weatherproof Flex Raceway each portable for routing of new horizontal cabling.
 - 3.5 Saw cut and Patch Asphalt as required.
 - 3.6 Provide all Trenching, Backfill, and compaction as required.
 - 3.7 Provide required underground and aboveground conduits; pull boxes, fittings, and elbows.
 - 3.8 Provide Horizontal cabling for (9) portables.
 - 3.9 Portables 19 thru 23 shall get Cat 6A indoor/outdoor rated cable.
 - 3.10 Portables 15 thru 18 shall get Cat 5e indoor/outdoor rated cable.
 - 3.11 Each portable will have (4) locations with (1) location in the ceiling for a WAP containing a white jack, (1) location at the top of the wall for an IP intercom speaker containing a green jack, (1) location with (3) data containing two beige and one blue jack, and (1) location containing (4) beige data jacks.. A total of (36) faceplate locations & (81) end station jacks, totaling (162) terminations. All Drops will be run from the New MDF. Label, test, and certify all copper terminations and provide test records. Proposal must Include Payment and performance bond.

Note: No more that (2) 90° bends between pull boxes. Comcast and AT&T pathway requires 24 inch bend radius/sweeps (or greater) for conduit sweeps. Contractor will be responsible for all City Permits and associated fees. See Lodi USD's "2017

Telecommunications Specifications" for cabling parts and installation requirements.
