The Flu Epidemic

This 2017-2018 flu season has been one of the worst in nearly a decade. It is currently in its peak season, which usually happens in February. Fifty three children have died in the U.S. because of the flu this season and many people all across the country currently have the flu. It is widespread in 49 states. Some schools, including ones in Illinois, such as the Illinois Math and Science Academy (IMSA) in Aurora, Illinois have closed because of high flu activity within the schools. Eighty eight out of the 637 students and 13 of the 55 staff members at IMSA had the flu, and so the school was closed all of last week so it could be cleaned and sanitized. Some symptoms for the flu are fever, runny nose, cough, sore throat, body aches, headaches, chills, and tiredness. Some people may have vomiting or diarrhea. Home remedies for the flu include drinking plenty of water, getting humidity (with steamy showers or a plug-in mist humidifier), gargling with salt water to get rid of mucus and germs in the back of your throat, and getting lots of rest. The flu is widespread this year, so make sure you get your flu shot, if you haven't already, to avoid getting the flu.

This is a new game that came out on November 2, 2017 worldwide.

It is an action shooter based on the Star Wars film franchise.

It was made by EA Dice in collaboration with Criterion Games and

Motive Studios, and published by Electronic Arts. It is also released for

XBOX One, PS4, and Microsoft Windows. Try it out!



Gameplay

Star Wars Battlefront II features a single-player story mode, a customizable character class system, and content based on *The Force Awakens* and *The Last Jedi* movies.^[3]



Multiplayer

Instead of the paid Season Pass downloadable content (DLC) seen in the 2015 predecessor, this game is expanded with free DLC provided to all players with a free EA account. Lead actress Janina Gavankar stated that the DLC would be free to all players, using a seasonal structure similar to *Overwatch* and *Rainbow Six Siege*. There are many playable heroes from each movie era, including: Luke Skywalker, Darth Vader, Emperor Palpatine, Boba Fett, Yoda, Darth Maul, Han Solo, Rey, Kylo Ren, Finn, Princess Leia, Lando Calrissian, Bossk, Chewbacca, and Captain Phasma; although, both Finn and Captain Phasma will be released in a wave of content after the initial release. The planet to be released alongside them is Crait, seen in the trailer for *Star Wars: The Last Jedi*.



Single player

The second iteration of this franchise will be featuring a campaign, similarly to the original Pandemic game of the same name, with a full campaign storyline rather than being solely focused on multiplayer as DICE's first *Battlefront* was. The game's single player protagonist, Iden Versio, leader of an Imperial Special Forces group known as Inferno Squad, played by Janina Gavankar, will be participating in the events leading up to *The Force Awakens*. There will be segments in the campaign where the player will be able to control characters such as Luke Skywalker and Kylo Ren.
