

Pawsitive Pride Discipline

Students might receive an Office Discipline Referral (ODR) if they are not showing Pawsitive Pride and have received reminders regarding their behaviors. If students receive an ODR, they will process with the principal the Pawsitive Pride expectations that were not followed and discuss how to make better choices in the future. An intervention will also be implemented which might include reteaching of Pawsitive Pride expectations, loss of a privilege, and/or parental contact. Pawsitive Pride follows the belief that every behavior has a purpose. It is our job as a school to teach appropriate behaviors and positively reinforce student behavior so they can make positive choices throughout the school day.
