

Pawsitive Pride Acknowledgement System

If students are being respectful, responsible, safe, or a learner they can earn Pawsitive Pride Slips. A staff member can give students a slip at any time throughout the school day.

Students are to place their Pawsitive Pride Slips into their classroom buckets, the Tower of Pride, or a small bin located in the cafeteria.

A student's name is drawn from each classroom every Friday. The Pawsitive Pride winners are announced at the beginning of each week. Pawsitive Pride winners are allowed to spin the Pawsitive Pride Wheel for the chance to earn a prize. Some examples of prizes include:

Lunch with the Principal
Huskie Stuffed animal
Picture with a friend/staff member
Huskie t-shirt

A group picture of the weekly Pawsitive Pride winners is displayed in the school as well.



The Tower of Pride

All of the Pawsitive Pride slips are periodically placed into the school's Tower of Pride. The tower is located in the elementary lobby. Once the Tower of Pride is full, the entire school celebrates everyone's efforts to show positive behavior. Some examples of celebrations have included:

Pajama and Movie Day
Holiday Celebration Day
Baseball Bistro
Field Day



Pawsitive Pride Traveling Flag

Classrooms are also able to recognize each other's positive behavior by awarding a Pawsitive Pride flag to display outside their classroom. The receiving classroom is able to pass on the flag to another deserving classroom after a few weeks.
