- Communicate with Head of Lower School, faculty, and nurses as needed.

- Ability to lift and/or carry an 11-year-old child.
- Physical endurance
- Proven experience as care giver to elementary age child
- Respectful and compassionate
- Strong ethics
- Willingness to adhere to health and safety standards
- Experience with cerebral palsy is preferred
