What is Haverford Online?

- Combination of online learning with instructional support by highly qualified Haverford teachers through direct contact, email and telephone.
- Continue to have all the services of our high school, guidance counselors, social workers, case managers for students with IEPs, also receive the service of our online teacher who supports all students in all classes.

Students Enrolling

- Enrolling and Recruiting students
 - Primarily School Counselors
 - Mailings/Phone Calls
 - Individual Meetings
 - Tour of Facility
 - Discussion of mixed possibilities
- Most students enroll in a course or two and take the remainder of their courses at the high school.
- A few students take their full schedule through the Online School.

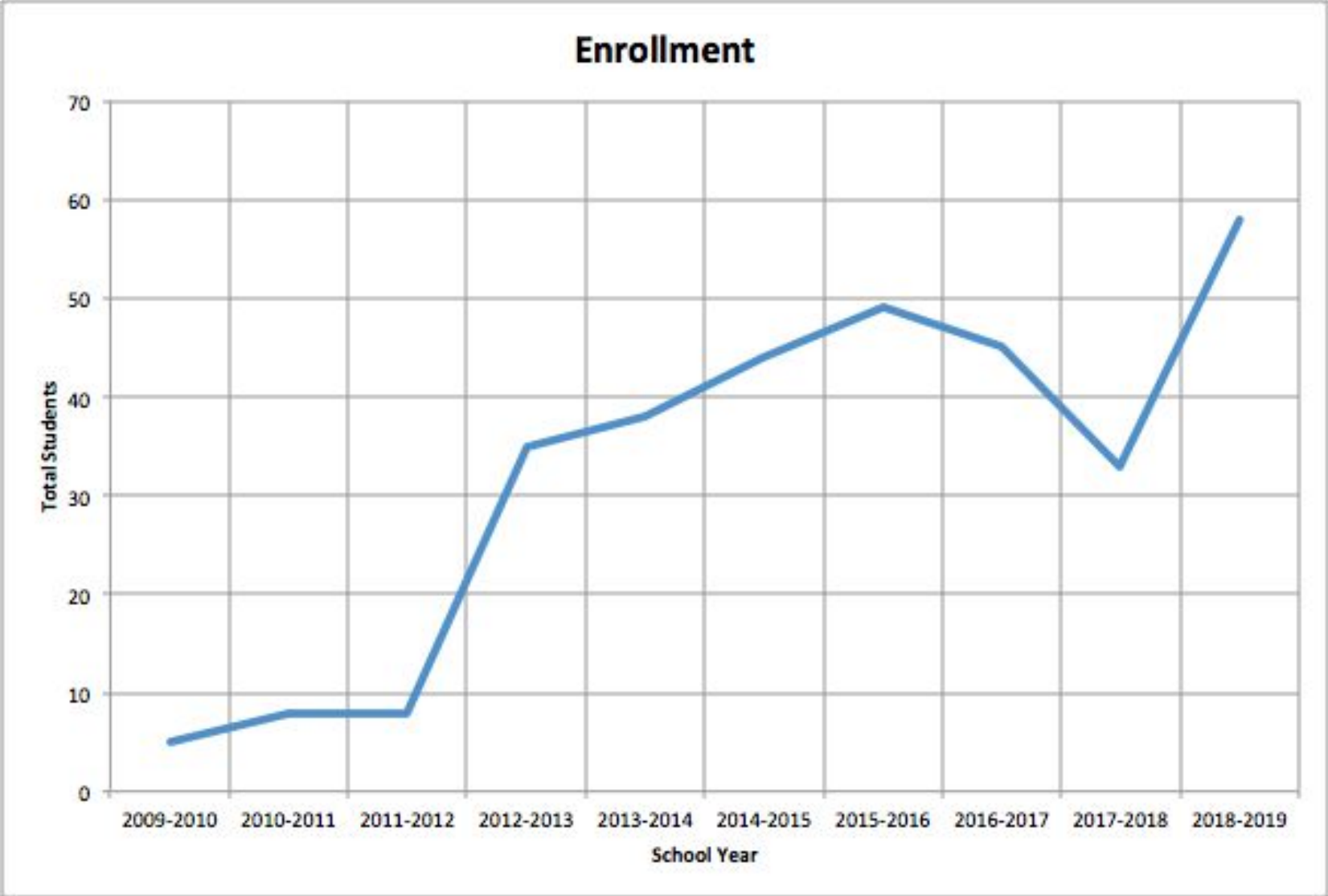
2018-2019 Enrollment

- 58 students enrolled this year
 - General Education: 43
 - Special Education: 15
- 50 different courses
 - Core
 - World Language
 - Electives
 - PE/ Health
- 4 grade levels

Enrollment



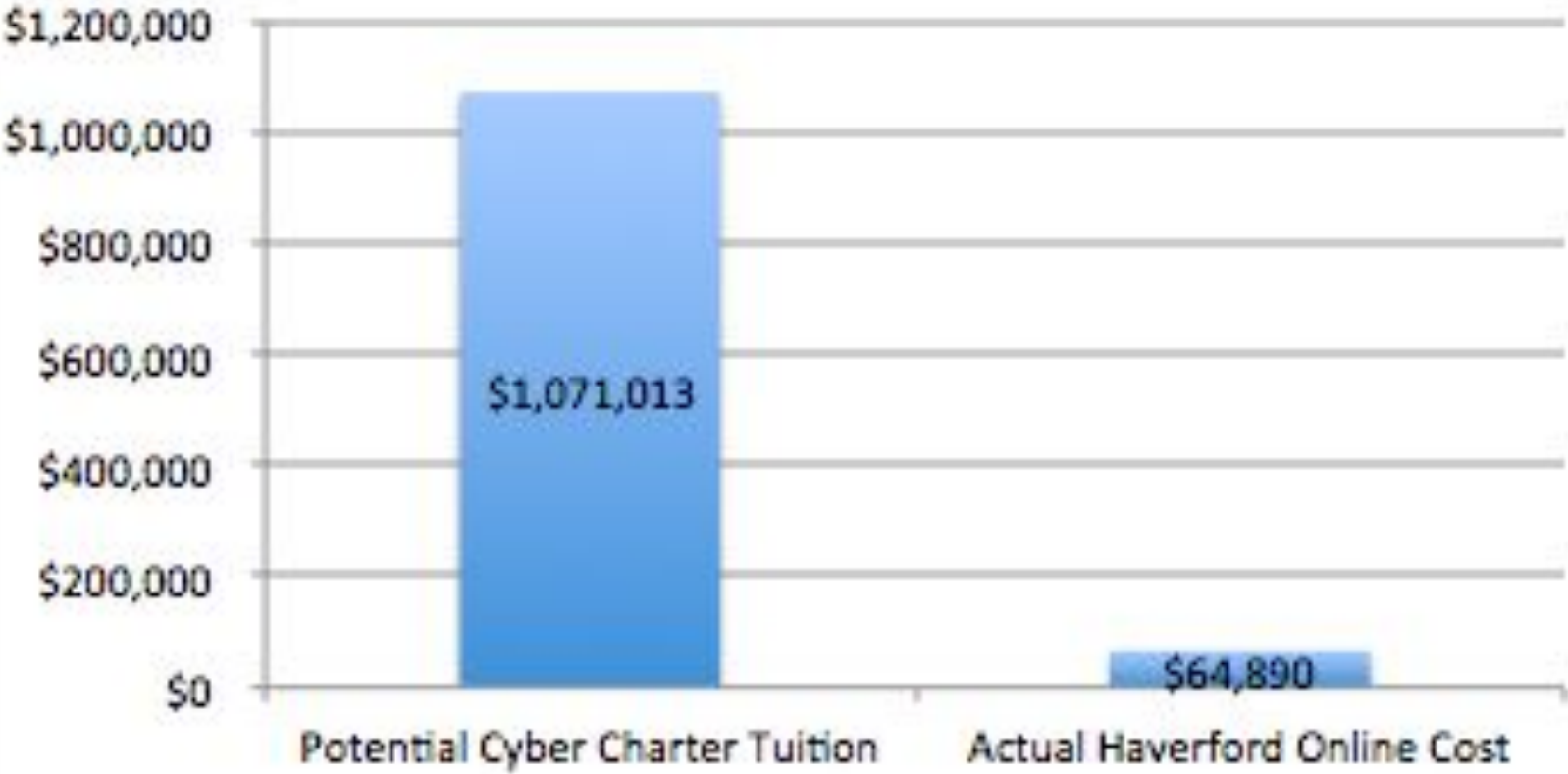
Haverford Online School

- Success of Program
 - Generally more than 90% of the students successfully pass their courses.
 - For students who do not pass, summer school and other options are pursued.
 - Over the past 5 years, 15/24 tested students passed Keystone Exams 62.5%
 - Most students who take classes online choose to take their Keystone classes in person
 - Students cite the flexibility of the classes as a reason for success.

Tuition Comparison

- Cyber Charter School Tuition
 - Special Education (15) \$34,762
 - Regular Education (43) \$12,781
 - Cost of Current 58: \$1,071,013
- 2018-2019 Haverford Online School Tuition to Date
 - Total License Costs 58: \$5500
 - Half - Time Supporting Teacher Pay and Supporting Teachers: \$59,390
 - Total: \$64,890
