Visual Art Applicant Prerequisite: Your portfolio shows a competency level equal to the completion of Studio Art 2.

The Afternoon Arts Visual Art Program is for serious and dedicated art students who have passion for it. You must have enough experience in art in order to work productively in an independent environment.

This program is your first choice of afternoon activities. If you have already tried out for a sports team, you are ineligible. Admission into the Afternoon Arts Program is granted after your proposal gets approved by the Arts Department.

Your application process:

- Complete this application and include a proposal. Your proposal should be emailed to Mrs.
 Nelson (enelson@thehill.org) and Mrs. Lim (ylim@thehill.org), and submitted by midnight of
 Sunday for the desired season. You are required to show your work at the end-of-term
 art exhibit.
- When you email Mrs. Nelson, request an interview time and date. During this 10-minute appointment, you will present your portfolio and elaborate on your goals for the term.
