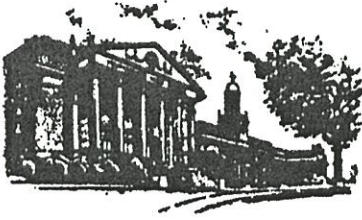

## 2019 MHS GRADUATION INFORMATION

### **Caps & Gowns:**

Distributed in Counseling Center on Wednesday, June 19, Thursday, June 20 and Friday, June 21 from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Seniors who have not paid the \$32 fee for cap and gown or who still owe texts, library books, athletic equipment etc. will **NOT** receive their caps and gowns until all obligations are met. School personnel will sign a release and forward it to the guidance counselor once the obligation has been met.

### **Rehearsal:**

Monday, June 24, 2019, 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.  
(Report to Auditorium) **MANDATORY**

Students will be seated in alphabetical order in the McLain Auditorium (Post Road). From there, students will proceed, row by row, in “the line of march” to Manchester Field (baseball field) for outdoor exercises.

### **Commencement:**

- A. FACULTY and STUDENTS will meet in the McLain Auditorium at 5:00 p.m. SHARP!!
- B. A group photo of graduates in cap and gown will be taken at 5:15 p.m. in McLain Auditorium.
- C. Commencement begins at 6:00 p.m.

### **Seating for Graduation:**

All guests will be accommodated outdoors on the baseball field. Chairs will be provided. Seating is on a first-come, first-served basis. No admission tickets are required. We are enclosing two graduation announcements for you to keep as mementos. These are not admission tickets.

### **In Case of Rain**

We are hoping for bright sunshine on graduation day. However, we have designated June 25th at 6 p.m. and June 26th at 10 a.m. as rain dates. If an indoor ceremony on June 26th is necessary, we will inform you via One Call Now alerts and also post information to the district’s website at [mamkschools.org](http://mamkschools.org). Should we have to go with this “rain” plan there will be extremely restricted seating and further instructions will be provided.

### **Handicapped Parking:**

The best place to park is on the side of the school closest to Starbucks. This will provide the easiest entrance to the baseball field.

### **Commencement Photography:**

Professional photographers from Island Photography will be present at commencement

to take a picture of each graduate as diplomas are presented and as they return to their seat. There will also be a class group photo taken before the ceremony (please arrive on time!) Within 48 hours after the ceremony, you will receive a link to view your proofs by email. Additionally, you will receive hard copy proofs placed on an order form, mailed home 5 days after the ceremony. These proofs are yours to keep; there is no obligation to purchase.

- *On prom nights, there are added police patrols throughout the county. And the county police, working with local police departments, will inspect all limousines going to and from proms at Westchester catering halls. If liquor is found, it will be confiscated. If the limousine has other safety infractions, it will be ticketed and possibly not allowed on the roads.*
