Job Description

The Civic Voices Fellowship will be responsible for carrying out important parts of the community and voter engagement outreach strategy working in South King County region. The fellow will support local organizations in partnership with Fuse by providing voter education and registration outreach resources. The Civic Voices Fellowship will grow and activate communities where voter turnout is historically low, piloting relational tactics and community-based solutions to low electoral engagement. The position includes significant leadership development, organizing training, and skills development.

Skills and Qualifications

This is a part time, learning position, while there are no required skills or experiences to qualify for this position preference will be given to those with a strong connection to communities in South King County. We are looking for applicants with a strong passion for advancing progressive values, social justice, and a desire to learn about the political process.

This position will require trips to various parts of South King County and thus access to a vehicle and valid driver's license are recommended but not required. Ability to work evenings and weekends.
