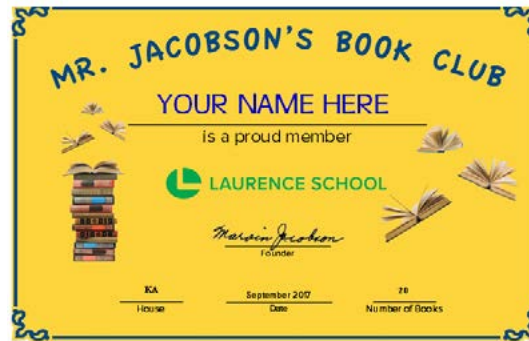




## HOW TO JOIN MR. JACOBSON'S BOOK CLUB
