# **Duty Instructions for Grade 2**

#### Recess Duty (11:10-11:35pm):

Please assist the students to get into quiet lines on the third floor, outside their classrooms (You do not need to worry about the 2 classes on the second floor, as Amy does this). Please take them out to recess really quickly, which is in the playground (every day for morning recess only). You watch the students and walk around your area.

Blow a whistle twice or call out for students to line up at 11:37pm (if not already lining up). Students walk quietly inside, wash their hands, and then they line up nicely to get their food. If the Grade 1 students are still leaving, they sit down in a long line, from the Tray Return Bins down to the bathrooms. If not, they can just walk right in. They should be heading into the eating area and lining up to get food by 11:45am.

### Lunch Duty (11:35-12:05pm):

Please supervise them during their lunch eating. They will raise their hands if they need to get up or get more food. Please walk over to them and help them/give permission to get up. At 11:55 am they can still get seconds. Amy will blow a whistle at 12pm, announcing that there is a 5 mins warning till leaving, NO more seconds.

Official dismissal is at 12:05pm. Quiet them down and dismiss by table. They must stay seated till they are dismissed.
