
PERSPECTIVES FROM TEACHERS & CURRENT STUDENTS

CONCEPTS over FACTS

- New trends in education to meet <u>21st Century Skills</u> (e.G. Negotiation, teamwork, service orientated, complex problem solving)
- <u>TIME MANAGEMENT</u>: What do I have time to do well and thoroughly? (e.g. Project Citizen, National History Day, Robotics, Band, Exploravision)
- <u>Emotional Intelligence</u>: Can you student reflect on their actions? Can they take the perspective of others? Why is this important?

TEACHER INSIGHT FOR QUEST PARENTS & STUDENT

- Concern for <u>overload</u> of students (in clubs, sports, academic extracurricular) Are your students in 3 or more extracurricular activities?
- How can parents & teachers provide emotional support as they navigate stress, high expectations, peer relationships/pressure & failures
