

Suggested Packing List

All personal belongings and clothing should be labeled with the student's name. If you forget to bring or are unable to bring some of these items to campus, they can be purchased new at local stores in nearby Middletown. Gently used clothes can also be purchased on campus at the St. Andrew's Alumni Clothes Closet (STAACC). Everything in the store is only \$1, and proceeds go to fund our financial aid program.

In mid-August, you will receive your roommate assignment & contact info. You may want to contact your roommate at that time to discuss what you are bringing and what you could share, so as not to bring duplicate items you don't need.

We recommend you bring:

Appliances

- Alarm clock
- Fan
- Desk lamp
 - Bulbs cannot be halogen or incandescent

Bedding & Bath Supplies

- Two towels
- Soap, shampoo, razors, deodorant & other personal hygiene items
- Shower caddy or toiletry kit
- Hair dryer
- Bath towels
- Pillow
- Two sets twin sheets (standard size)
- Comforter, quilt, blanket, or bedspread

Clothing

Laundry & Cleaning Supplies

No need to bring coins; our machines are free.

- Laundry bag or basket
- Detergent
- Stain remover
- Mesh garment bag (to keep bras from snagging/stretching in the wash)
- Hangers
- Disinfectant wipes for cleaning your bureau, desk, etc.

Note: All IV Form students are provided with laundry service for the entirety of their sophomore year, and do not need to bring laundry supplies to school.

School Supplies

Most of these items can be purchased at the School Store after you know what each of your teachers requires, but a few starter materials may be helpful.

- Laptop
- A planner and date book
 - III Formers will be provided one by the School
- Backpack or bookbag
- 3 to 5 notebooks
- Paper, pens, pencils, highlighters
- Post-it notes
- Scissors & tape

Miscellaneous (Optional)

- Under-the-bed storage
- Plastic containers for all food kept on dorm
 - Required if you plan to keep food in your room
- Padlock for your top bureau drawer (for storing any valuables)
- Posters and family pictures
 - Posters must be appropriate, as described in the Student Handbook
- Bulletin board and/or dry erase board
- 3M hanging hooks and/or velcro strips
- Small area rug (no bigger than 9'x12')
- Mug, bowl, plate, spoon, fork
- Water bottle
- Umbrella
- Extension cord
- Flashlight & battery
- Bicycle, rollerblades, or skateboard, plus lock
- Helmet
 - Must be worn while biking, rollerblading, or skateboarding

You may NOT bring:

- Halogen or incadescent lamps, for both safety & environmental reasons
 - CFLs or LEDs are permitted
- Candles, combustibles, matches, lighters, knives, or weapons of any kind
- Coffee makers, hot pots, or any cooking item with a heating element
- Refrigerators (allowed for seniors only)
- TVs, DVD players, or video game consoles
- Posters or decorations with inappropriate and/or salacious messages, or alcohol or drug-related content
- Air conditioners
- Bedroom furniture to use in place of SAS furniture
- Wireless hubs
