
All library books are due to the LLC by Friday, May 31st.

Enrolment and 2019/20 Class Lists

As we wind down the 2018/29 school year and continue to plan for next year, we are very pleased with the high retention and strong growth patterns that have emerged. As of this writing, we have 92% student retention, which is highly desirable in an international school setting. We are also pleased that over 70 new students have elected to join ASHK next year thus far. We anticipate that this number will grow significantly in the months to come as we have received numerous applications in the past few weeks alone. To that end, we recently decided to add two new classes to handle the overflow and are currently interviewing prospective teachers to join our expanding school community. We're quite confident that our enrolment projection target will be surpassed once the new school year begins in August 2019.

We will soon start assembling the class lists for the 2019/20 school year. Teachers will meet and discuss student assignment to both homeroom and Chinese Studies classes.

During the process of assigning students, we strive to evaluate and meet the academic, social, and emotional needs of each child and ensure there is a balanced dynamic in each class. This is a thorough process and is intended to provide a foundation of support for your child/children as they transition between grades and teachers.
