Be prepared to sell yourself with confidence & make a great first impression with these tips!

1.Know who will be at the job fair ahead of time

Do your research by going to the employers' career site. Read their mission, vision, people, values, etc. If you are interested in the organization or the industry, make sure to introduce yourself and tell them what you appreciate about their organization and what you can offer them.

2.Know what you can offer the employer and prepare a 30 second infomercial
