As a Technology Pilot classroom, devices are a common tool used throughout the day to enhance the learning environment. The Technology Pilot teachers will use the matrix below as a guideline for disciplinary action in their classrooms. The teacher and building administration hold the right to alter and deviate from the matrix, and treat each incident individually. The matrix is a guideline for staff and administration.
