

INSTRUCTIONS TO RISING ALGEBRA II STUDENTS SUMMER ASSIGNMENT

Dear Future Algebra II Student,

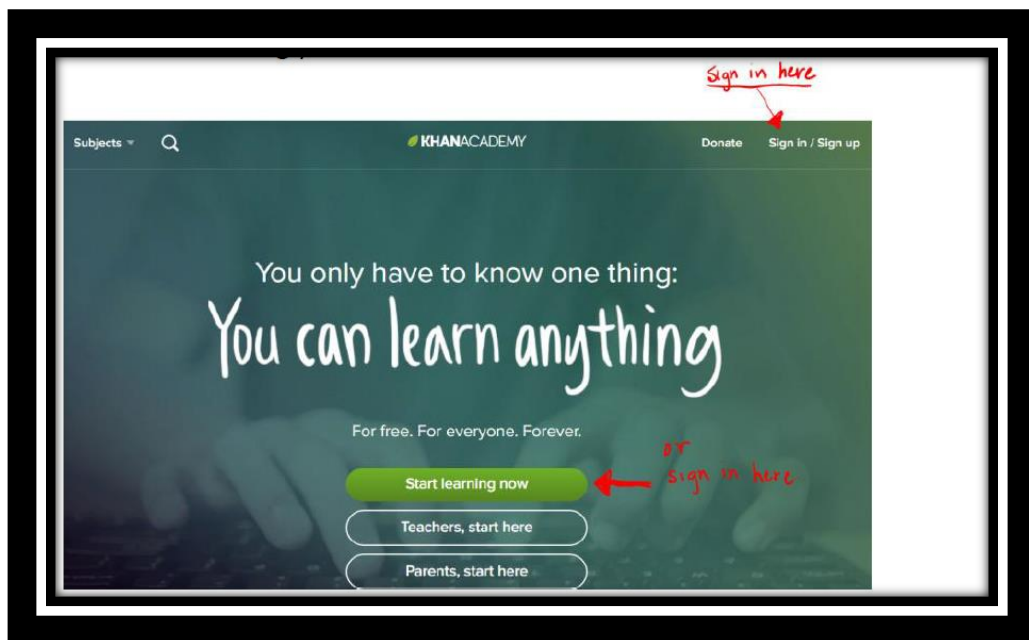
Your summer work is on Khan Academy this summer. Please sign up based on the course you will be taking next year.

1) JOIN THE CLASS BY GOING TO

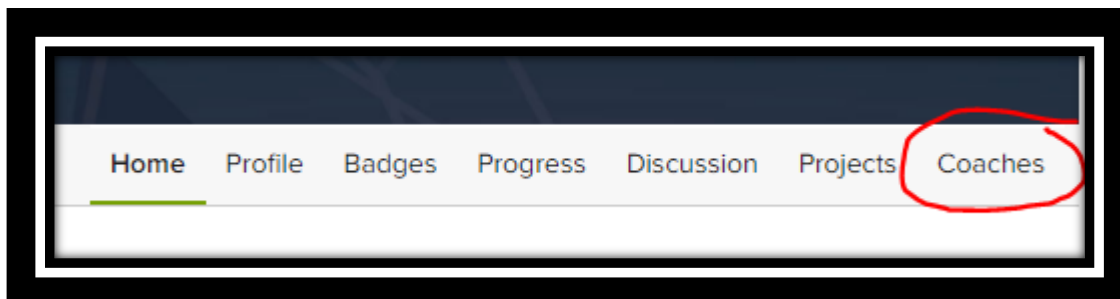
2) SET UP OR SIGN INTO YOUR ACCOUNT USING YOUR EMAIL ADDRESS

If you already have an account associated with your Holton email, sign in with that account; otherwise, set up a new account using your email. The email account you use does NOT have to be a Holton account but should somehow let us know who is associated with the account (i.e., the email holtongirl@gmail.com does not allow us to know who you are:)



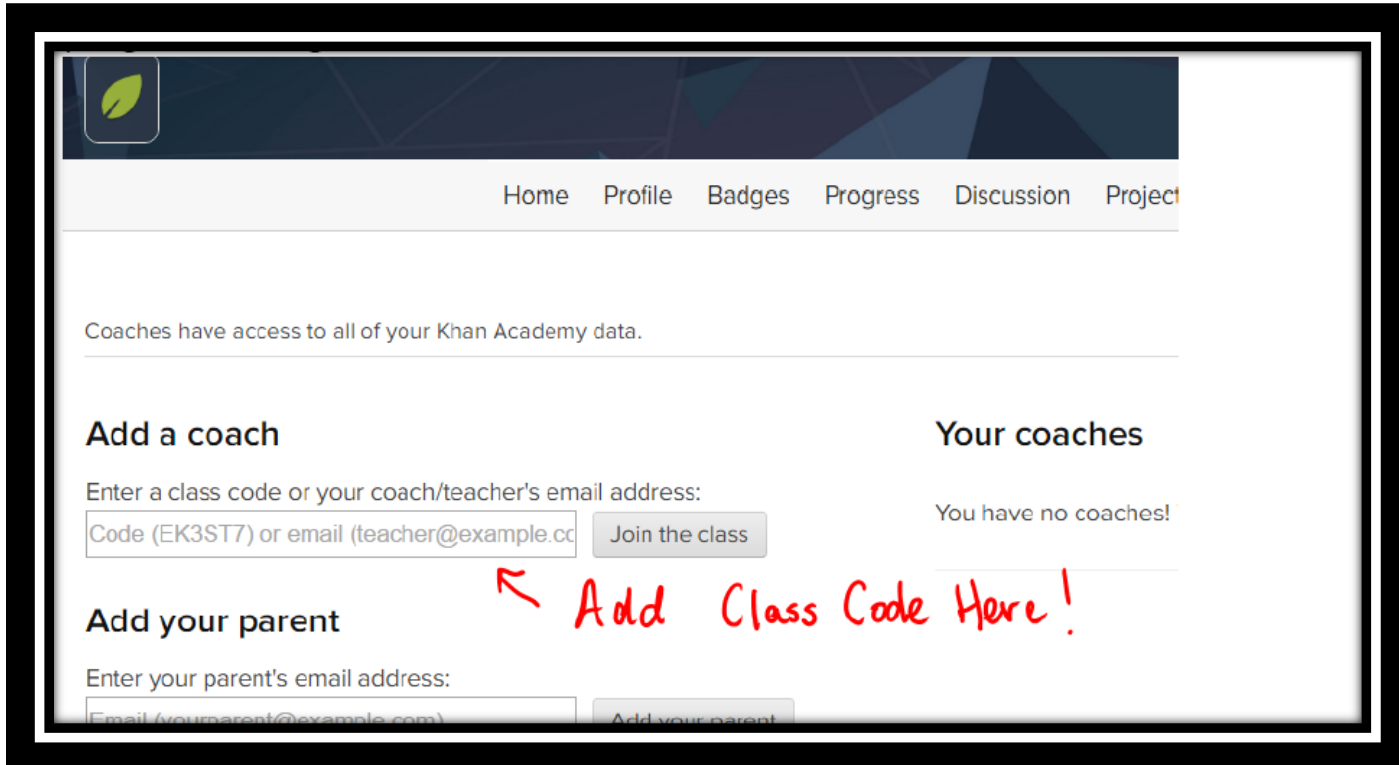
3) ADD A COACH

Click on the COACHES tab. After signing into your account, you can join a class by clicking on the COACH tab.



4) JOIN THE APPROPRIATE CLASS

At the next screen, you should be able to add our class code, allowing your future instructors to monitor your progress throughout the summer.



On this screen, enter the appropriate class code based on the level of Algebra II you will be taking in the fall:

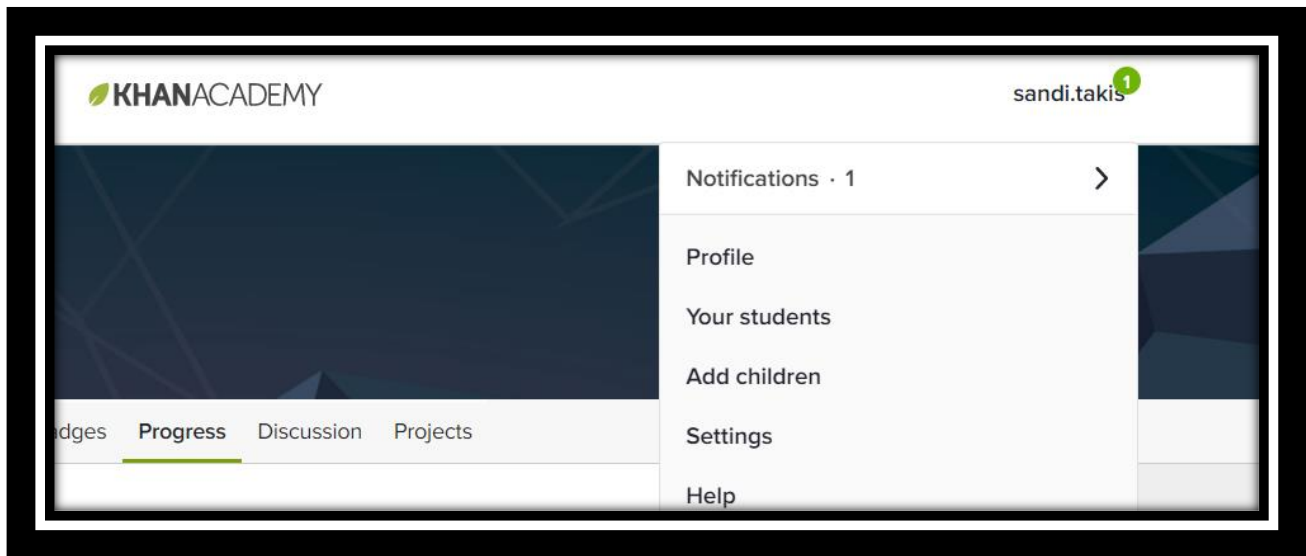
Level of Algebra II	Course Code

Then add your parent's email, and click JOIN THE CLASS to initiate the Holton Summer Assignment work.

5) WAIT FOR YOUR TEACHER TO SEND YOU THE ASSIGNMENTS THROUGH KHAN ACADEMY

Assignments do NOT filter automatically when you sign up. Rather, your teacher must log in and send out your work. BECAUSE OF THIS DELAY, DO NOT WAIT UNTIL AUGUST TO SIGN UP. Once you have joined the course, you will receive notifications about the specific work you should do over the course of the summer in Khan Academy's Algebra I course. You DO NOT need to do the entire course. However, we have selected several topics that we would like you to practice. If you know the material well, each topic should only take 15 minutes to complete. If you need review of the topic, there will be several links associated with the topic including videos to watch that will help you with the work.

You will find the NOTIFICATIONS in the upper right hand corner of the screen by clicking on the green circle next to your name. Click on the GREEN CIRCLE by your name, and then click on the NOTIFICATIONS link to see your assignments and your progress on these assignments.



GUIDELINES FOR SUMMER REVIEW

- 1) Work 1-2 hours per week generally. Do not leave the work until the last week of summer. There is too much material to cover in one day.
- 2) Weekly practice will help you retain these important algebra skills for your future math courses.
- 3) Your teacher will be able to see how much time you are spending on each unit and how often you are accessing the website.
- 4) Use the website to its fullest. You can ask for hints to help you do specific problems. If you don't have any idea how to do a set of problems, watch one or two of the recommended videos. Feel free to email your teacher as well if you have questions. You do not need to keep any written work, but you may want a notepad and a calculator handy as you do the work.
- 5) Your progress will be incorporated into your first TRIMESTER grade. GOOD LUCK!
