- 1. Message from Principal Denhalter: I find myself chuckling a bit inside when, in May, people ask me how the school year is winding down. It's going great, but I feel the school year never winds down, but especially in May, seems to pick up pace dramatically, until the school year eventually ends. With this week coming to a close and the last week quickly approaching, I felt it may be helpful to send out a message to you. With all of this information being shared, I wish to simply, but sincerely express my gratitude for your support in having such an amazing school year.
- 2. Picnic in the Playground: Columbia Elementary has a long-standing tradition of holding a Picnic in the Playground for the purpose of building community and celebrating the end of a successful school year. The weather is acting like it may not cooperate with us. Regardless of the weather, we'll hold this event. No, you don't need to wear your rain suit. We'll make a last-minute decision and if the playground is wet or overly soggy, we'll invite families to set up their picnic blanket in the classrooms, cafeteria, or on the stage. Regardless of whether we're inside or out, we ask that all visitors enter through the main entry, sign a clipboard, and wear a school sticker. After checking in, you may check your students out with the classroom teacher. We'll begin at noon and end at 1PM. If your children are checked out with the teacher, you may take them home with you. Children who are not checked out will leave at normal dismissal time at 1:25.
