#### **Primary Duties and Responsibilities:**

The Associate Athletic Trainer will deliver athletic training services to athletic team(s) assigned by the Head Athletic Trainer. Duties include:

- The prevention, evaluation, treatment and emergency care for injuries occurring during games or practices.
- Communicating a student-athlete's injury status to the head coach of assigned team(s), determine when an injured student-athlete is permitted to return to practice or game and communicate that to the head coach.
- Supervise and evaluate athletic training students assigned by the academic department.
- Travel, weekend, and holiday work is required (50-70 hours/work week).

#### **Qualifications:**

- A Bachelor's degree is required; a Master's degree is preferred.
- NATABOC certification for minimum of three years and CPR/First Aid certification required.
