School Board Meeting Highlights  
May 20, 2019  
Work-Study Meeting**

At the May 20, 2019 Work-Study Meeting of the White Bear Lake Area School Board, the following items were presented and discussed:

1. **Big Sleuth Update.** Director of Technology and Innovation Mark Garrison and a team of district staff members provided an update on the district's first year of the Big Sleuth process, which had more than 500 staff members participating by advancing ideas, commenting on and voting on others' ideas, and designing and testing new solutions.

2. **Community Survey Results from the Morris Leatherman Company.** Peter Leatherman from The Morris Leatherman Company presented to the School Board the results of a recently conducted residential survey concerning questions related to the recommendation by the District Facilities Planning Committee. The survey, administered from May 6 through May 10, 2019, included a 650 random household sample of the School District.
