1	Update on WIN Block	Brian Siesto gave an update on a potential WIN block at Victor High School. A sub-committee from the Building Leadership Team visited Pittsford Mendon High School on Tuesday, March 26 th to meet with their WIN planning committee and visit their WIN block. This was the first of a 2 day WIN block for Mendon. The second day was scheduled for Friday, March 29 th . The WIN block focused on academically focused core subject areas: 3 subject areas on the first day and 3 different subject areas on the second. If a teacher was not working with students on a specific day, they were busy planning in professional learning committees. This was the second year that Pittsford Mendon High School has piloted the WIN program. After evaluating this year's experience, they hope to be able to offer it on a more frequent basis. The program takes extensive planning and thoughtfulness to incorporate. At VSHS, Tony Montone is working on the challenging task of developing an equitable WIN block into our existing class schedule.
