Dear Parents,

We recently completed the Dibels testing. We made significant growth! I am very pleased with the progress that we made from the beginning to the end of the year. This is due to good tier one instruction in the classroom, and the intervention groups. Kindergarten to third grade started the year at 69% proficient and ended the year at 86% proficient, which is a 17% increase, which is incredible. Overall as a school, we start at 72% proficient and finished the year at 85%, which is a 13% increase, which is awesome as well. With this data, I again encourage you to set time aside every day for your children to read and do some math. It will only take a few minutes each day to continue what your child has learned and will help prepare them for next school year.




