The educational technology teacher and integrator reports to the director of educational design and innovation and works as a member of a team that supports and advances the school's technology, media and innovation programs.

Responsibilities include:

- Teach weekly technology skills classes to 5th and 6th graders
- Teach a twice-weekly technology elective class to 7th and 8th graders
- Supervise a robotics club
- Assist in providing technical support, technology coaching, and technology training to teachers

In spring 2018 the school completed a transformative campus project that includes renovation of the quad and amphitheater at the heart of the campus and the construction of a new Learning Commons, Digital Media Lab, and Creativity Lab. The new learning spaces are designed to support student-centered inquiry, hands-on discovery and tinkering, collaboration, and design thinking.
