

## 2019 SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM NEWS RELEASE

Mesquite ISD will offer *free* nutritious meals this summer for all children ages 1-18. The Summer Food Service Program offers free breakfast and free lunch to any child. Children do not need to be part of Mesquite ISD to participate and no advance qualifying or registration is required. All meals provided are the same for all regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service.

Due to Health and Sanitary Rules, all meals must be eaten on site; no part of the meal may be taken away from the site. Adults may purchase a breakfast for \$1.50 and lunch for \$3.00 at most participating locations.

Please reference the list below to locate the participating campus and serving times nearest you. Signs will be posted around each campus with directions into the cafeterias, usually entrance is at the rear of the buildings.
