Technology Requirements For August 2018 <u>GUIDELINES FOR PURCHASING DEVICES</u>

All secondary students must have access to a computer with an internet connection for research and work while at school and at home.

Grade 9-12 students are expected to come to school in August 2018, with their own Apple laptop. Grade 8 students will be expected to come to school in August with their own Apple laptop or Chromebook.

In cases where a family is unable to provide the required Laptop, the family can borrow a school device for the school year. Please inform us asap if you need to borrow a school device. (swinderlich@acst.net)

IMPORTANT NOTE: This offer is only available for the 2018-19 school year.

Grade 6 and 7 will be issued a school laptop to use while they are on the school campus. These devices will not be taken home so these students will need access to a device at home for homework as needed.

Other

- Identification Badge: Students, staff, parents and visitors are provided an identification badge with their photo, name and barcode with information (i.e. lunch balance). *Please wear your badge while on campus.*
- Lockers: Each student is provided a 90 cm tall by 40 cm deep by 30 cm wide locker with a secure combination lock. Students are not to share lockers or combinations. A backpack needs to fit inside this space.
- Leave valuables at home: All are responsible for their valuables at all times.
- PE & Sports changing rooms do not have lockers. Valuables are not to be left unattended.
