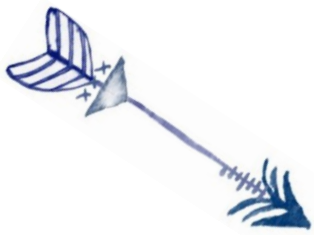

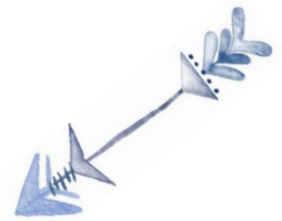

Registration Steps

1. Log into your Unified Classroom account at <https://classroom.powerschool.com>. (If you have any issues logging into your Unified Classroom account, please email pshelp@min201.org.)
2. Click on Quick Links in the navigation bar.
3. Click on Portal Login Home
4. Choose the appropriate student.
5. Click on Returning Student Registration button at the bottom.
6. Confirm that you are at least 13 years of age by checking the checkbox.
7. Click the green "Begin Form" button.
8. Verify your student's date of birth.

It is important to note that this form can only be completed in a web browser either on your phone, tablet or computer, not the smartphone PowerSchool app. The form only needs to be filled out once per student by a parent or guardian.

Once you get to the form you will need to fill it out and upload 2 proofs of residency. 6th graders will need immunizations and a physical, a dental form and a PE uniform. If you have any further questions about registration please contact us at the main office: 815-467-4692

Lunch Fees are collected on the first morning of the school week. The 2018-2019 lunch fee is \$2.70 per day (includes milk). Skim white and chocolate milk can be purchased separately for \$.30 and Lactose free milk .60. Reminder: At the beginning of the school year, all students are provided a lunch card. Should it be damaged or lost, it must be replaced in the office for a fee of \$5.00. Please note that our menus can be subject to change.
