

## FOR ALL eHEALTH STUDENTS

The state of Kansas now requires all health education students demonstrate that they are able to perform hands-only CPR on an adult mannequin, perform CPR (compressions/breaths) on an infant mannequin and be able to operate an AED machine.

There are three (3) components we have added to the eHealth Edgenuity course:

1. View the CPR videos included in the first unit of the course in Edgenuity under First Aid
2. Upload the CPR assignment to Edgenuity after answering the questions about the CPR videos
3. Schedule a day/time to be checked off for performing CPR and using an AED machine. Dates, times, place and instructions on how to sign up will be emailed to all eHealth students within the next week. We will work to get everyone checked off during the first two weeks of the course. If you are unavailable during this time frame, you will need to make other arrangements with your eHealth instructor.

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
