

## Registration Timeline for 2019-20 School Year

To register for the 2019-20 school year, you must use the new course numbers that are published in the *current Course Offerings Guide*, or you can find the new course numbers on the registration website at [www.edenpr.org/ephs](http://www.edenpr.org/ephs). The registration link will be active beginning January 31<sup>st</sup>.

(Students should turn in materials even if they have registered on-line.)
- February 12** **On-line Registration Closes.**

***Special Notes:*** Due to weather related school closures, we have extended our Registration Window through February 12 so that each student / family has the opportunity to get accurate information to make the best registrations decisions possible.

*It is extremely important that all students register between January 31 and February 12 as course offerings will be based on this registration information. The offering of courses described in the Course Offerings Guide will be based on student interest and availability of resources.*
