

Beaverton High School Summer Program 2019

Original Credit: Health 1

This **Health 1** summer course provides the same breadth, depth, and rigor as its classroom counterpart but in an accelerated format. Students successfully completing this course will gain the skills, knowledge, and experience offered in a full-semester Health 1 course, and will earn a 0.5 credit for Health 1.

Dates: Monday – Thursday, June 24th - July 25th, no school July 4

Class Time: 8:30am-10:20am

Cost: The cost for this class is \$350 and includes all materials for the 19 days of the program. Students with Free/Reduced lunch status may be eligible for reduced fees. Student/parent must provide a copy of their Free/Reduced paperwork from Nutrition Services when registering. **(BHS staff does NOT have access to this paperwork).** Contact program staff at BHS-Summer-School@beaverton.k12.or.us with questions.

Beaverton High School Summer Program Health 1: Original Credit

Course Description: 5-Week Original Credit Class. Each class meets for two hours per day.

Health 1 (9-12) **H201X**

Prerequisite: none

One semester/0.5 HE Credit

Tuition: \$350

Students will have the opportunity to explore health-related issues such as mental and emotional health, violence prevention, alcohol, tobacco & other drugs, human sexuality, including transmitted infections, and unintentional injury prevention. The focus in this class is on accessing information and developing strategies for improving communication, problem solving, and decision-making.

General Information

Cost: The cost for this class is \$350 and includes all materials for the 19 days of the program.

Attendance: A parent/guardian must call 503-356-2830 the day of the absence to excuse all student absences and tardies. A student will be considered absent if they are more than 30 minutes tardy. If a student accumulates 2 absences or 2 tardies, a program coordinator will require a meeting with the student and her/his parent/guardian to determine if the student will be allowed to remain in the course. There is **no fee refund** if a student is dropped because she/he accumulates more than 2 absences or 2 tardies.

Transportation: No district transportation will be provided; however, passes for public transportation can be arranged upon request.

Behavior: Students are expected to follow all school rules and regulations. The program director may drop a student who violates any of the academic, attendance, and/or behavior rules detailed in the BSD Student Parent Resource Handbook. There is **no fee refund** if a student is dropped for a violation of the Student Code of Conduct.
