

Beaverton High School Summer School 2019

<u>Credit Recovery Program Overview</u>

The Beaverton School District is very excited to be launching our district wide Summer 2019 Credit Recovery program. As a student, you will have the opportunity to choose from a menu of core courses for classes that you have previously earned a D grade or failed. When you successfully complete a course during the summer, **you will earn a Pass (P) grade on your transcript. If you had failed the course originally, you will also earn 0.5 credit.** The original course grade will convert to an N (in the semester the course was originally taken) and the improved P will be entered on your transcript. If the same or lower grade is earned, the original grade will remain and an N will be transcripted to indicate a repeated course. If a course is not offered at your home high school, you may enroll at another comprehensive high school offering the course.

Our commitment to you: As educators it is essential that we are not only supporting you in earning credits, but most importantly that we are helping you develop the skills needed for success at the next level of your educational development. This program has been developed with your future needs in mind. With this essential goal as our priority, we have incorporated some unique and supportive elements to our program to ensure your success. Some of these include:

- ✓ Small class size
- \checkmark Direct teacher instruction
- ✓ Standards-based curriculum that is aligned to our own courses so you are regaining credit while simultaneously preparing for the next course in your academic sequence
- \checkmark A wide range of courses offered across many curricular areas

Students' commitment: Earning a semester of credit (0.5 credit) in the shortened summer session is not a task to be taken lightly. We are committed to providing all of the supports possible for your success, but you will need to understand that this amazing opportunity will require a strong commitment. Daily attendance and staying on pace with coursework will be essential for you to complete the course in a 5-week period. You will need to spend time on the work outside of your in-class instruction time if you expect to finish on time. **All courses meet at BHS and require regular attendance, whether they are direct instruction or FLEX Online classes.**

Please carefully review the registration information and application. **Submit your application with payment to the main office by June 20, 2019.** If you have questions about what courses you should take, please contact your counselor. We are looking forward to providing this valuable opportunity to you.

BSD Summer School 2019

Credit Recovery Program - General Information

<u>Eligibility</u>: Current 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students who have earned a D or F grade the first time they took the course. Successful completion of the summer school course will result in a P (Pass) grade. This includes students who previously earned a D grade in a course.

When you successfully complete a credit recovery course during the summer, **you will earn a Pass (P) grade on your transcript.** If you had failed the same course previously, you will earn 0.5 credit as well. The original course grade converts to an N (in the semester the course was originally taken) while the improved P is noted on the transcript. If the same or lower grade is earned, the original grade will remain and an N will be transcripted to indicate a repeated course.

Attendance:A parent/guardian must call 503-356-2830 the day of the absence to excuse all student absences and
tardies. A student will be considered absent if they are more than 30 minutes tardy. If a student
accumulates 2 absences or 2 tardies, a program coordinator will require a meeting with the student and
her/his parent/guardian to determine if the student will be allowed to remain in the course. There is no
fee refund if a student is dropped because she/he accumulates more than 2 absences or 2 tardies.

Transportation: No district transportation will be provided. Public transportation passes can be arranged upon request.

- Homework Policy: All students will have daily homework. The teacher assigns due dates to all assignments and students must turn in assignments on time.
- **Behavior Policy:** Students are expected to follow all school rules and regulations. The program director may drop a student who violates any of the academic, attendance, and/or behavior rules detailed in the BSD Student Parent Resource Handbook. There is **no fee refund** if a student is dropped for a violation of the Student Code of Conduct.

Cancellation Policy: Individual course sessions may be cancelled or consolidated if they do not fill to capacity.

refund will be granted upon request.
