Dear Prep Families,

I am writing to remind the community of several important rules and expectations regarding student parking and driving on campus at Prep and the University. There are several points which are important:

- The number of drop-offs and pick-ups on the west side of campus has increased, and the University Department of Public Safety has asked us to remind our families that drop-offs in Prep Alley are not permitted for safety and traffic reasons.
- Students are reminded that they may only park in designated areas such as the Lower Lot and the Dolan Lot.
- Students are not permitted to park in the Campus Parking Garage. This will result in the vehicle being towed immediately at the owner's expense.
- Students are not allowed to park off campus in residential areas. The University has a standing agreement with the Town of Fairfield which does not allow it.
- When driving on campus, students must drive safely and have a real situational awareness about how we share the campus with the University Community. There have been several concerns relayed to Prep about how student driving has caused disruptions.
- There have been several complaints made regarding tickets being issued to students, boots being placed on vehicles, and vehicles being towed. All are results of not following the rules, which the students are well aware of.

We appreciate you having a conversation with your sons regarding our concerns. Student safety and respect for the rules are our most important concerns. Students whose names recur will ultimately have their privilege of driving to campus revoked. In the future, we ask that you please communicate your questions and concerns via email to parking@fairfieldprep.org and not to the University.
