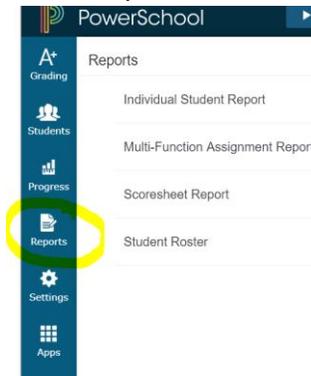
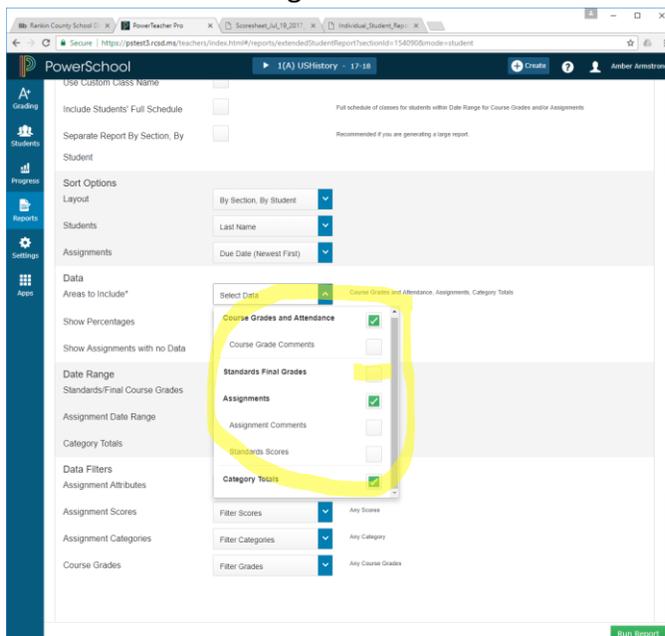


## 6-12 Grade Progress Report from PowerTeacher Pro:

- Select Reports from the Charms bar on the left hand side



- Select "Individual Student Report" from the menu
- Give your report a title (optional)
- Select your classes by clicking the Select Classes drop down menu, check the box next to each class to show on the progress report. (\*\*See bottom of this guide for how to choose your classes\*\*)
- Select your Sort Options:
  - o Layout: By Student
  - o Students: Last Name
  - o Assignments: Due Date (Newest First)
- Select the Data you want to include from the drop down menu (see picture below):
  - o Uncheck "Standards Final Grades".
  - o You can uncheck Assignments to just show your Course Grade to date.
  - o Uncheck Category Totals
  - o Check the Assignment Comments to include Comments



- Select Date Range for Standards/Final Course Grades, Assignment Date Range, and Category Totals. This should be the current term you are printing progress reports for. IE- Q1, Q2, etc.  
**\*\*\*NOTE: Even though it says Standards/Final Course Grades it is not going to show a Standards grade for ANY grade levels. \*\*\***
- Set your Data Filters to Any Assignment, Any Scores, Any Category, and Any Course Grades

- Below is a screenshot of what your report should look like. The yellow highlighted areas are areas you will want to set.

Criteria | Students | Format

Report Title: Individual Student Report

Description: Multi-function report per student. Useful for progress reports, missing/late assignments, low grades, high grades, category totals, and more.

Classes\*: Select Classes (1 Class: 6(A) Science 6)

Use Custom Class Name:

Include Students' Full Schedule:  Full schedule of classes for students within Date Range for Course Grades and/or Assignments

Separate Report By Student:  Recommended if you are generating a large report.

Layout: By Student

Students: Last Name

Assignments: Due Date (Newest First)

Data

Areas to Include\*: Select Data (Course Grades and Attendance, Assignments)

Show Percentages:

Standards/Final Course Grades: Select Reporting Term (Q1)

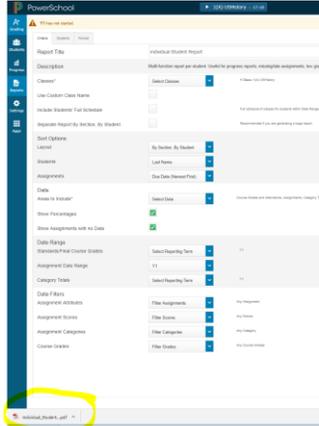

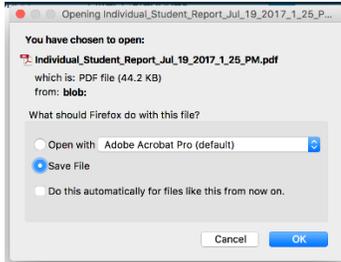

- Change the Orientation to Portrait
- Check the box to include the Signature line

- Click Run Report button at the bottom right.
- This creates a PDF file:
  - o In Chrome this PDF file is downloaded automatically. To open it, click the downloaded file in the bottom left of your browser window:



- o In Firefox, it will ask you what you want to do with this file:



- o Select to Save File or Choose to Open with “Adobe Acrobat Pro”
- o In Safari this file is automatically downloaded. Click the “Show Downloads” button at the top right to see your file and open it:



**- Choosing your classes:**

- o Selecting only one of your classes will print your progress report like this, only the selected class on a sheet for each student will print: (this student was in the selected 6(A)Science for this teacher)
