COURSE DESCRIPTION

Provides students with apparel or interior design opportunities using soft goods/textiles and construction/production skills which will focus on entrepreneurial opportunities and careers in design fields. Experiences may include pattern design, apparel design and construction, fitting and alteration, and interior design projects. The study and application of textile sciences and technology in this course provides students with laboratory-based experiences that will strengthen their comprehension of concepts and STEM standards.
