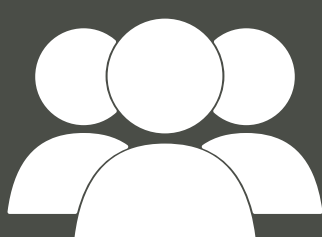


SAFETY IS ON OUR MINDS



Safety Personnel

Did you know that Franklin Pierce Schools has a Safety, Security and Emergency Mngt. Supervisor, 3 school resource officers (PCSD Deputies), 5 security officers and a Dean of Students at all schools?



Safety Planning

Did you know that the Franklin Pierce Schools Safety and Security Manager works with staff from across the district to develop and implement safety plans in each of our schools?



Safe Buildings

Did you know that Franklin Pierce Schools is installing access control systems in each of our schools? This includes electronic locks, surveillance cameras and emergency notification systems.



Safety Communication

Did you know that Franklin Pierce Schools now has the ability to send out phone calls, emails and mobile notifications in the event of an emergency? Be sure to update your contact information in Skyward.



Safety Coordination

Did you know that Franklin Pierce Schools coordinates with school districts, law enforcement agencies and first responders across Pierce County to prepare for emergencies?



Safety Support

Did you know that Franklin Pierce Schools has a "Flight Team" made up of school counselors, social workers and psychologists to support students, staff and families after an emergency occurs?

EMERGENCY PLANNING GUIDE

Before an Emergency

- Make sure your school has the correct contact information on file
- Sign up to receive messages on School Messenger
- Follow Franklin Pierce Schools on Facebook
- Talk with your child and teacher about the school's emergency plan
- **If you see something, say something.** Contact the school, district office or anonymous hotline at 1(855)-4(ALERT)1

During an Emergency

- Please resist the urge to come to the school grounds during an emergency
- Please refrain from sharing unconfirmed information about the emergency
- The school and/or district will offer timely communication through the autodialer, Facebook and email
- If you are instructed to come to the school to reunite with a student, please bring your photo ID

After an Emergency

- Discuss the emergency situation with your child
- Contact your child's school if your child could benefit from additional support following the emergency
- Make sure that your school has the correct contact information on file
