

Grades 6-8 Theatre Bio Instructions

- Bios are submitted electronically when you complete the registration process via UltraCamp. There is no need to bring a printout of your bio to auditions.
 - Other than lead roles, bios should be approximately five lines (7 inches long, 12 pt. Font); lead role bios should be NO longer than seven lines.
 - The body should be written in the third party (he/she, his/her).
 - Start with First Name, Last Name followed by your role in parentheses, i.e. Susie Smith (Peter Pan). If you do not yet know your role, leave this out.
 - Numbers, such as grade or age should be written out. (Seventh grade versus 7th grade).
 - Shows included within are to be typed with the role in parentheses, i.e. Annie Jr. (Annie).
 - Do not include any text formatting (e.g. bold, italic, etc.)
 - **You do not need to say you are a student at Cincinnati Hills Christian Academy because all cast/crew/orchestra members in our theatre productions are students at CHCA.**
