## Get a Head Start on College Work .... While You're in High School



Your AP Exam scores can earn you college credit before you even set foot on campus—and let you skip introductory college courses.



Earning credit or placement can open up time on your schedule or even let you graduate early.



“AP” on your high school transcript shows colleges you’ve tackled college-level work.



AP students are better prepared for college than students who don’t take AP and more likely to graduate in four years.



Time management, critical thinking, scholarly writing—AP courses help you hone the skills you’ll need in college and career.



Nearly 70% of colleges (U.S.) accept AP credit.



**CONNECTICUT** ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in the entire nation in having the largest percentage of public high school AP students scoring a ‘3’ or higher on an AP Exam.

[Note: Massachusetts ranks first with 32.9%, Connecticut is second with 32.2%, National average is 23.5%].
