

May 15, 2019	Financial mailing sent to parents, including first billing.
July 1, 2019	Payment of first billing due for Plan A and B, Tuition and CAA. Tilton School Ram Card deposits due.
August 29, 2019	Registration for pre-season athletes and new international students.
September 2, 2019	Registration Day (no student may proceed with registration until all arrangements for payment of tuition, other fees, and past due bills have been made with the Controller.)
November 1, 2019	Plan B tuition payments and CAA payments due (Plan C payments must be current before semester assessments begin in January).
May 1, 2020	Final bills generated. All accounts must be current before final assessments begin in late May/early June.

School Policy on Payments:

- A) No student may proceed with registration until all arrangements for payment of tuition, other fees, and past due bills have been made with the Controller.
- B) Students whose accounts are not paid in full by the assessment period at the end of each semester may not be allowed to participate in the assessment process.
- C) Students with significant unpaid balances at school vacation and long weekends may be asked to postpone their return to school until all balances are paid.
- D) Seniors must have all payments complete in order to receive diplomas at Graduation.
- E) On all interim billing, payment is due on receipt if there is no credit balance.
- F) Ram Card Accounts should always have a \$100.00 balance and replenishment of account is expected.

Day Student Meals:

Day student tuition includes the cost of daily school lunches **only**. When day students have formal evening commitments at school, such as play practice, a performance, or committee meetings, they are invited to attend dinner at no charge.

Day Student Overnights:

Day students are not normally permitted to stay overnight in their day student rooms. However, special arrangements may be made with the Dean of Students if an overnight stay is necessary. For longer than one night, a fee is charged based on the difference between day and boarding rates.

The student handbook contains more information on student policies and expectations. We encourage all parents and students to read and become familiar with these policies. The handbook is published online and hard copies are distributed during orientation.
