Thursday, August 29

Helpful Resources for Travel Planning

HOMESTAY PROGRAM: The Student Life Office and International Student Coordinator collaborate to offer a Homestay Program for international and long-distance boarding students. This allows students who are not able to travel home for long weekends or Thanksgiving Break with the opportunity to stay locally with a Tilton School family. There is no fee. If you are potentially interested in having your child partake in a homestay opportunity, please contact the Student Life Office at studentlife@tiltonschool.org. *Homestays are not available for Winter and Spring Breaks.*

AIRPORT SERVICE: Located 40 miles south of Tilton, Manchester-Boston Regional Airport is New England's most convenient airport, with a growing schedule of non-stop, direct service flights throughout the country. Logan Airport is located in Boston, Mass., 96 miles southeast of Tilton.

Concord Coach also provides transportation on a regular schedule from Logan Airport Terminals A, B1, B2, C, and E for a fee. Students can take Concord Coach to Tilton, N.H., where a school shuttle will greet them, or to Concord, N.H., where they can take a taxi to campus (approx. 20 minutes).

Campus transportation is provided free of charge from the Tilton Junction bus stop as listed above. Students and their families are responsible for arranging a ticket on the Concord Coach bus line from Boston Logan Airport or Boston South Station bus terminal. Students should visit the Student Life Office for assistance when booking their travel arrangements.
