

## 2019 Summer Pre-AP English II Assignment

**DUE: Monday, August 26 (A) / Tuesday, August 27 (B)**

1. Students will connect their Khan Academy to their College Board results for PSAT.
  - a. Go to the North Garland HS webpage
  - b. Click on “Academics”
  - c. Click on the Khan Academy link under online resources
  - d. Instructions for setting up an account and linking an account are on the district webpage that will load after clicking this link.
  - e. If students have not yet taken the PSAT, they can still create an account without linking their account to the College Board by following the instructions provided.
  - f. If for some reason College Board account does not link student has to take diagnostic quiz through the program this counts for your time requirement.
2. Students need to put in **10 hours** during the summer, which their next year’s teachers can see through Khan Academy.
  - a. Students will work through the given assignments and tutorials
  - b. They are set up to work with areas that you are having trouble.
  - c. Students will create a log sheet that has four columns
    - i. 1<sup>st</sup> column will be the date they are working on Khan SAT Prep
    - ii. 2<sup>nd</sup> Column will be the start time
    - iii. 3<sup>rd</sup> column will be the end time
    - iv. 4<sup>th</sup> column will be the total time you have worked during each session
    - v. Also include the total time logged, which must be **at least 10 hours**
3. When students return next year, they will have two weeks to put in their hours
  - a. This is for students who did not have access to a device that connects to the internet, or able to get to local library.
4. After two weeks, students will take a released PSAT test on English only to access standings to aid in achieving National Merit Scholarship Quality Test standards.
  - a. Grading for students will be on accomplishing hours for 80 points
    - i. Turn in Log sheet to teacher
      1. Will be double checked for activity done in Khan Academy
      2. 10 Hours 100 Percent of the first 80 points
      3. 9 hours 90 Percent of the first 80 points
      4. 8 Hours 80 percent of the first 80 Points
      5. 7 Hours 70 Percent and so on.
  - b. 20 points of assessment will be score on released test
    - i. If they reach a score of 730 on their test they receive a 100
    - ii. All improvements are based on PSAT 9/ diagnostic quiz
    - iii. Improvement of 50 points receives a 90 of the 20 points
    - iv. Improvement of 40-49 receives 80 of the 20 points
    - v. Improvement of 30-39 receives a 70 of the 20 points
    - vi. Improvement of 1-29 receives a 60 of the 20 points
