Acceptance into the SNHS is a way to recognize high school students for their success in the sciences. The eligibility/membership requirements and responsibilities, as recommended by the SNHS, are:

- Minimum 3.0/4.0 scale GPA
- Minimum 3.5/4.0 scale GPA across all science courses.
- Junior standing at time of application (Sophomores if currently taking an AP science course)
- Has taken an honors level science course during their Freshman or Sophomore year
- Enrollment in an AP science course during their Junior year
- Attend all of required meetings each year.
- Assist a teacher in a practical or regular level class four blocks during their junior year (must be completed before the end of the school year) and four blocks during their senior year (must be completed by the end of the 3rd quarter). The teacher will sign off on the blocks you helped.

** (GPA's must be maintained and will be checked periodically after acceptance)
