<p>Grab some snacks such as pretzels and goldfish. Create a pattern such as pretzel, pretzel, goldfish and repeat it! Then try making a different pattern. What do you notice?</p>	<p>Pick two numbers. Tell which one is greater. How do you know?</p>	<p>Write the number that is: Ten ones and 2 more ones Ten ones and 4 more ones Ten ones and 7 more ones</p>
<p>Got a toy with wheels? Push it from a starting point. Measure how far it went using spoons! Try measuring with other items! How many shoe lengths did it go?</p>	<p>Measuring liquid is fun! Use a 1 cup measuring cup to fill a container. How many 1 cups did it take to fill your container? Experiment with different containers and see what you notice.</p>	<p>Draw a circle in chalk on the sidewalk. Take 10 soft items (bean bags or rolled up socks) and try to toss them into the circle. Keep track of how many land in and how many land out for each round. What do you notice?</p>
<p>Pick a board game and play. What math do you do while you play the game?</p>	<p>How many years old are you? How many more years until you turn 10?</p>	<p>Make up your own math activity today and share it right here!</p>
<p>Count to 100 by 1's and then by 10's.</p>	<p>Today's number is 7. Write equations to show different ways to make 7!</p>	<p>Walk outside! What shapes do you see? Draw them and label them.</p>
