<p>Going grocery shopping? Compare prices of 3 different brands of sizes. Which one is the least expensive?</p>	<p>What kitchen containers are measured in milliliters? Line them up in order from greatest capacity to least capacity.</p>	<p>Count by <math>\frac{1}{4}</math>'s until you get to 3. Put your count on a numberline! If it is a nice day put it on a chalk number line outside!</p>
<p>Catching up on summer reading? How many pages are in your book? If you read 8 pages a day, how many days will it take you to finish it?</p>	<p>Measuring liquid is fun! Gather measuring cups and some containers. How many 1 cup full fits in a container, how many <math>\frac{1}{2}</math> cups? How many <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> cups? Experiment with different containers and see if you can find a pattern!</p>	<p>Count out 50 objects. (Could be goldfish, legos, pennies, or any small object.) Put them in equal groups. How many different ways can you divide them into equal groups?</p>
<p>Practice your math facts! Make up a song to remember them.</p>	<p>Going to the movies? If you bring \$20 will you have enough to pay for your ticket, popcorn, and a drink? Explain.</p>	<p>Estimate how many inches wide a window is in your home and then measure to the nearest inch. Were you close?</p>
<p>It is 2019. In what year will you be double your current age? In what year will you be 4 times your age?</p>	<p>What is your favorite movie? How long is it? If you start watching it at 2:30 what time will it end?</p>	<p>How many ways can you make \$1.00? \$10.00?</p>
