

- High percentage of information is not updated regularly, and may be created by questionable sources.

- Editorially selected best of publisher quality articles and websites that are reviewed and updated regularly and meet K-12 curriculum and state standards








BOOKFLIX, FREEDOM FLIX & TRUE FLIX

- The program helps to build literacy concepts, such as identifying important details and integrating knowledge.



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
- FreedomFLIX includes eBooks for the entire Cornerstones of Freedom series by Scholastic.




HOMEWORK HELP

Live online tutoring, writing help, and research databases




- BrainFuse offers live tutoring from 2 to 11 p.m. daily.
- Tutoring is grade level and topic specific.
- Students are capable of creating a whiteboard or chat space to communicate with classmates when they can't meet in person.
- Practice activities and tests can be saved in a free account.
- Tutors are qualified instructors, and have cleared background and reference checks.




PEBBLEGO & KIDS INFO BITS




- Pebble Go is designed for beginning researchers and offers easy navigation.
- Learning experiences are available via text, video, audio, read along and more.
- The program is meant for emergent readers, from preschool through third grade.
- The content includes reproducibles and games.




- Kid Info Bits allows early researchers to search for articles on a variety of topics.
- Search results can include magazine articles, news video clips, newspaper articles, pictures and excerpts from books.
- The articles can be read to users.
- Results can be sorted by Lexile Level.
- Kids Info Bits can be useful to children in a variety of ages and grade levels.



WHAT DO I READ NEXT?



- NoveList K-8 Plus offers book recommendations and reviews from book experts.
- Users can search by subject, title and author.
- Some results have book discussion guides included.
- Each selection offers title, series or author read-alike lists.
- Lexile Levels are included.
- Selections are linked to the TPL Catalog. That way, it's easy to find out if a book is available to check out.
