## HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SPRING

#### LACROSSE - VARSITY

- Overall Record: 9-10-1
- Ranked 35<sup>th</sup> in Illinois (up from 48<sup>th</sup> last year)
- Played a competitive schedule including two teams in the top 10, and eight teams in the top 25 in the state.
- > 17 different players scored goals, 10 of which were seniors
- ➤ Biggest Win: Defeating Conant 17-11, after losing 13-0 last year.
- > The program will look to the JV team to re-build and replace the graduating seniors.

#### LACROSSE - JUNIOR VARSITY

- ➤ Overall Record: 13-3
- The three games lost were all by one or two goals. The girls were in every game this season. This was as a strong a JV program.
- Goals were scored by 11 different players.
- The team prided itself on tenacious defense and strong goalie play.
- The midfielders had a strong year, gaining and keeping possession for the team in most games.
- Many of the girls are ready to contribute at the varsity level next year.

#### LACROSSE – FRESHMEN

- Overall Record: 2-12
- Players developed well, many of which were in their first year of competitive lacrosse. Throwing and catching, as well as rules of the game were learned. These skills will have to be mastered along with strategic understanding for the girls to earn meaningful minutes at the JV level.
- > The teams record does not indicate how much the girls improved. There are strong athletes on the freshmen lacrosse team, and the team played against many schools where freshmen had come to high school with previous lacrosse experience. If the girls continue to work hard they will close the gap next year.
- The coaching staff is extremely proud of the freshmen team and confident the girls will add depth to the lacrosse program moving forward.

#### SOCCER – VARSITY

- ➤ GCAC Record: 4-3 Overall Record: 11-9
- > Team was in contention for the Conference Championship and the Pepsico Showdown Championship until the final weekend of the season.
- > Seven freshmen started a varsity game this year.
- Senior Amy Talley had 13 goals and 4 assists.
- Junior Clare Dillon led the team with 7 assists.
- > Senior Viviann Markech had 12 goals and 6 assists.

- Did not allow more than two goals in a game for the final 17 games of the regular season.
- > Players committed themselves and jumped up several levels in their game.
- The team dealt admirably with many injuries this season.
- ➤ The girls played each game with a competitive spirit, but also great sportsmanship.

#### SOFTBALL - VARSITY

- ➤ GCAC Record: 1-11 Overall Record: 7-21
- > GCAC Red Division sportsmanship winner. Sixth year in a row
- ➤ Key wins: Ignatius, Regina, and Fenwick
- > Team started a freshman and three sophomores. The team hopes to build from this strong, young nucleus.

#### SOFTBALL - JUNIOR VARSITY

- ➤ GCAC Record: 9-6 Overall Record: 18-6
- Finished 4th in the GCAC Red Regular Season.
- Took second in the GCAC Playoffs, defeating #1 seeded Providence.
- Girls worked hard and improved greatly!

#### TRACK AND FIELD

- > Team was led by Captains Bridget Zegler and Mary Claire Weber.
- Biggest Win: Defeating Regina at home.
- Team finished second in the GCAC White Division.
- > Top Team Finishes: Varsity placed 4<sup>th</sup> at the Montini and Bloom Township Meets. JV placed first at the Montini Meet.
- The team grew to 42 members this year.
- Every girl on the team recorded a personal best in competition this year.
- Eleven girls were GCAC All Conference: Tess Minasian, Madison Dorband, Ally Ferraresi, Nayelli Soria, Lola Genyk-Huntsinger, Ann Quinn, Mary Claire Weber, Grace Sondermann, Anna Snider, Margaret Buxtin, Rebecca Gawlinski.

- ➤ Varsity Record 3-18. JV Record 0-12
- > Ten new girls joined the team this year. They all showed remarkable improvement throughout the season.
- ➤ Biggest Victory: Defeated Latin at home on Senior Night 8-7.
- > Samantha Rickert was named to the "All Sectional Team" at the Glenbrook North Sectional.
- ➢ Best Memory: Defeating Vernon Hills 17-3. Multiple players scored their first goal that night.
- > The team grew to 22 players this year (with 7 freshmen), and played a full JV schedule. The younger players will build on this in-game experience for next year.
