

WHY THIS TOPIC

- We can relate to it
- > Time gap affects language fluency
- ➤ L2 fluency of interest to researchers (Schmid et al., 2016)
- Lack of L2 English fluency research with younger groups

WHAT IS (DIS)FLUENCY

- Various definitions in L2 acquisition (Redford, 2015)
- ➤ In our research, disfluency disruption in the flow of speech hesitations and repair

WHY THIS PROJECT


- University level research

EMERGING FINDINGS: FILM RETELLING TASK


- Overall disfluency decreased over the summer, but the participants also spoke less
- Significant increase in unfilled pauses (vs. filled) postsummer
