Dear AP Spanish IV students,

The AP Spanish Language and Culture course in the fall develops a student's proficiency in the four language skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing, as well as focusing on Hispanic culture.

Communication will be the focus, written and verbal methods, therefore grammar will **not** be the focus in AP. You will be working toward comprehension of authentic, native Spanish, and you will be expected to respond using the target language. The syllabus presupposes a solid knowledge of the Spanish verb and pronoun systems, as well as a reasonable proficiency in listening comprehension, speaking, reading and writing. Control of grammar will help you demonstrate command of the language.

The goals of your summer assignments are:

- ✓ to help you maintain your current level of Spanish
- ✓ to improve your vocabulary and listening skills
- ✓ to increase your knowledge of cultural and political topics
- ✓ to raise your awareness of current events and their effects on the Spanish-speaking world

The Summer Assignment:

- You will pick from the following “scavenger hunt” list in order to earn up to **150** points.
- Sign up for ¡Yabla! Several of those videos will be on the “scavenger hunt possibilities”
- Know the important verb list (not all knew Sp.1-3) *1st vocab quiz are over these

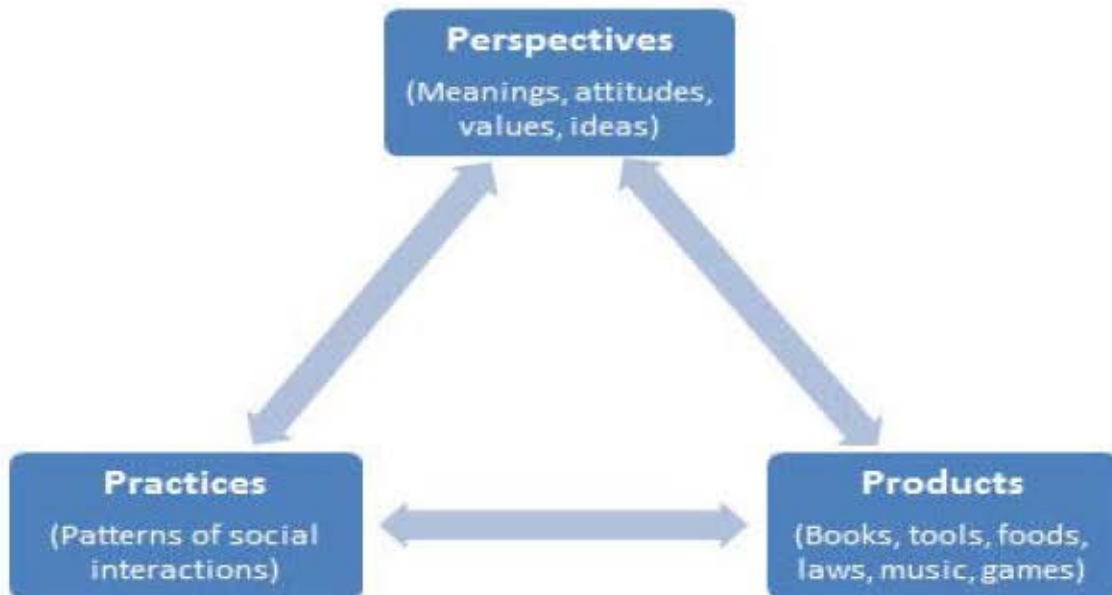
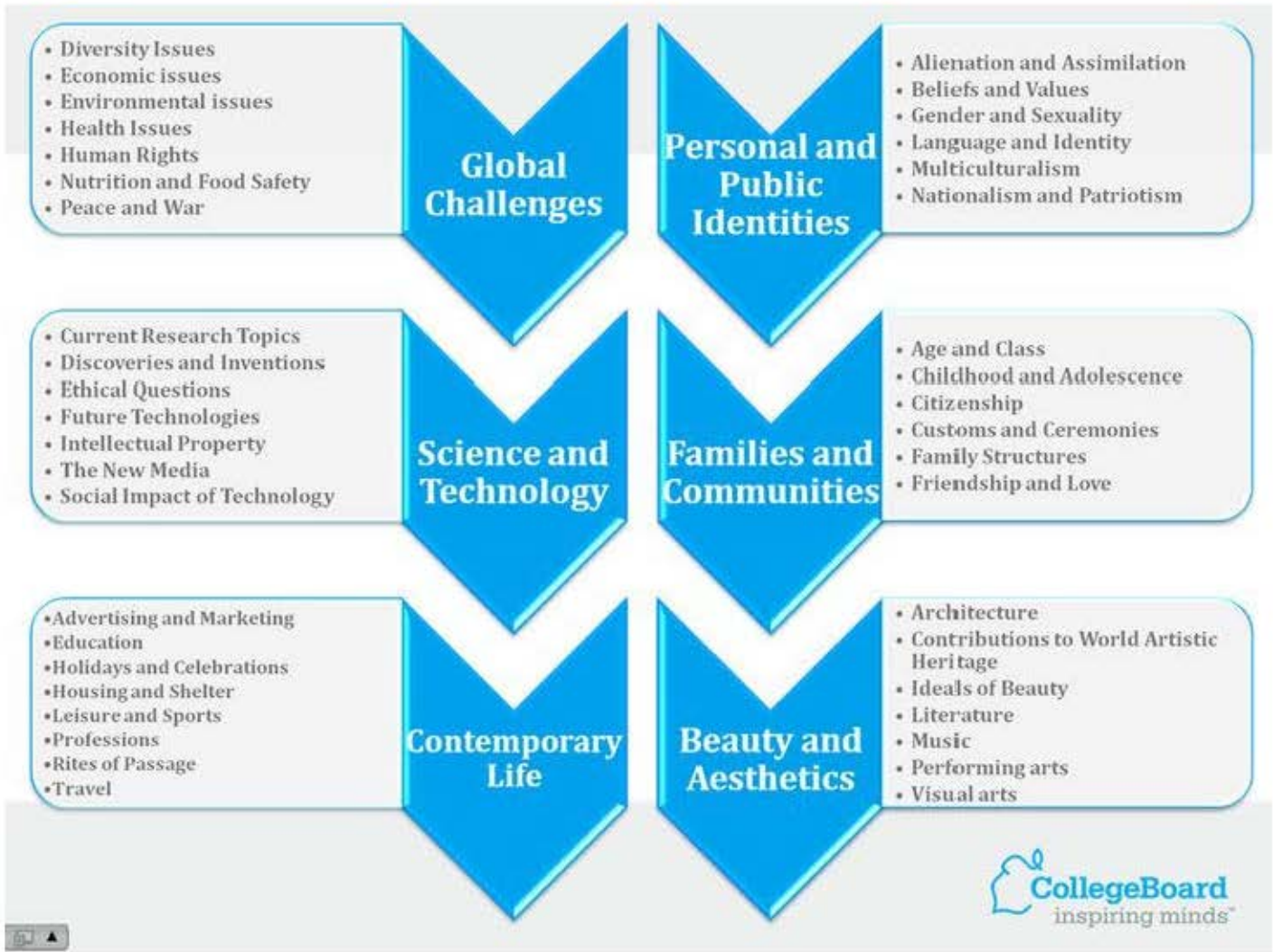

- 5 pts: Bring in a menu all in Spanish (No English!)
- 10 pts: Photo of you with a sign or billboard in Spanish. Bring pic to class.
- 30 pts: Read a newspaper or magazine in Spanish. **Bring it in** and explain what it says.
 - o Try: Mundo Hispánico (newspaper), People en Español (magazine), BBCMundo (español)
- 20 pts: Create a Spanish hashtag on Instagram. Hashtag appropriate Spanish pictures (at least 10 pics) that influence you and show them to the class.
- 40 pts: Learn (and be able to sing) a song in Spanish. Sing it in class.
 - o +5pts Bonus for song that you DIDN'T learn in class.
- 10 pts: Make friends with someone your age from a Spanish-speaking country on Facebook. Print out proof. (be safe with this one 😊, email me if you need help)
 - o +10 pts: Have a conversation all in Spanish. Print it out & bring it in.
- 5 pts: Find a funny Spanish meme online. **Print and bring to class.** (up to 2)
- 30 pts: Record a Spanish telenovela (soap opera) and watch it several times until you understand everything they are saying. Tell us about it in class.
- 50 pts: Make a video with some friends acting out a telenovela plot. Use only Spanish. Must be **5 min.**
- 25 pts: Record & watch a soccer game in Spanish. Record yourself watching it. upload recording
- 40 pts: Record yourself "announcing" the game, play by play (10 plays or 3 min long whichever is 1st)
- 40 pts: Watch a Netflix show in Spanish (w/ English subtitles) and be ready to discuss it with the class.
- 100 pts: Travel to a Spanish-speaking country and show power point of pictures to the class
 - o +10 pts: bring me a souvenir!!! 😊
- 30 pts: Make a purchase at a Hispanic grocery store. Take a picture in front of grocery store with your purchase and bring it to class.
 - 5 pts: Drink a soft drink from a Spanish-speaking country and bring in the can/bottle. (Inca Cola, Jarritos, Mexican Coca-Cola, etc...)
 - 100 pts: Volunteer with a community ESL class, helping Spanish-speaking people learn English. Show pictures. Discuss in class.
 - 10 pts: Read the news from a Spanish/Latin American news website, print it and bring it in. **** This can be used from the log we will use**
 - o Maximum of 5 will work for this one.
- 10pts: Collect 10 different items that have Spanish written on them. Bring them to class. 1 pt. per each item that has Spanish on it. (max 10)
- 10 pts: Find your favorite YouTube video in Spanish and write down the link. (tutorial makeup, how to)
- 40 pts: Post a YouTube video of you doing something interesting while talking/explaining it in Spanish. Must be at least 5 min. Write down the link. (like giving a tutorial, explaining how to's, what to do..)



- 10 pts: Video yourself tasting some spicy Mexican candy.
- 50 pts: Buy an all-Spanish music album: Target or iTunes is your **best bet**. Bring it to class to listen to.
- 50 pts: Write a travel post of “must do/ see” attractions from, **Houston**, here, places you have been.
- 35 pts: Make a Spanish dessert for your friends/family (churros, **flan**, sopapillas, tres leches cake, arroz con leche...) Take a picture & bring it in.
- 45 pts: Make a Spanish dinner for your friends/family (arroz pollo, paella, enchiladas, Cuban sandwiches, gazpacho, fajitas, chilaquiles...) Take a picture and bring it to school.
- 45 pts: Learn and recite a work by a famous poet in Spanish.
- 15 pts: Switch your Facebook to “Spanish” mode. Take a picture and bring it in. + 5 pts: make a list of 5 vocabulary words in Spanish. (Ex. ¿“Profile picture” or “add a friend” en Español) Bring the list to school.
- 25 pts: Memorize a Bible verse or portion of another religious text in Spanish. Recite it in class.
- 20 pts: Listen to Spanish radio & learn a commercial jingle to sing to the class.
- 20 pts: Annoy your little brother/sister (or older) by talking to them only in Spanish for an entire day. Record their frustrated responses for posterity to show to class.
- 50 pts: Buy a true Spanish movie with English subtitles. Watch it and bring it to class. Describe the plot in Spanish to the class.
- 20 pts: Go to a Mexican (any spanish country) restaurant in town and record yourself ordering your meal in Spanish. Show the video in class.
- 50 pts Go to: <http://lyricstraining.com/>
 - o Pick at least 5 songs (10 pts ea.) that you would like to master in the summer. You will be able to show the class one by doing it in front of the class. The rest can be done at your desk in order to receive the credit.
