

HIGH SCHOOL

Algebra 1 -Pencil, erasers, ruler, two size A4 spiral notebooks with graphing paper. (only graphing paper, NOT the lined paper) The calculators used for the math department at ICSB on the high school are the TINspire calculators. We will use this calculator for Algebra 1

Algebra II - Pencil, erasers, ruler, one 2 or 4-ring binder with loose-leaf graphing paper size A4 (can be the smaller binder), dividers for the binder, TINspire calculator

Anatomy & Physiology-One 2 or 4-ring binder, colored pencils (not markers) – set of 24, 1 spiral notebook

AP Calculus- 2 or 4-ring binder with loose-leaf paper, pencils, pens, highlighters, personal TI graphing calculator REQUIRED.

AP European History- Two A4 notebooks

AP Human Geography- One 2 or 4 ring binder, notebook, colored pencils

AP Literature and Composition- Perforated notebook (lined paper), binder with multiple sections (minimum 6 sections), 1 book cover, color pens

Art 1-A4 (or larger) sketchbook, pencils, erasers, pencil sharpener

Biology- One 2- or 4-ring binder, 1 spiral notebook (college-ruled), graph paper, 1 pack college-ruled paper, colored pencils (not markers)

Chemistry- One 2- or 4-ring binder, #2 pencils, index cards (not required, but highly recommended), one pack college-ruled paper, scientific calculator (does not need to be a graphing calculator), graph paper (notebook), ruler

Christian Studies 9- Bible (NIV or ESV), small 2 or 4 ring binder, journal (Small Tesco style is suitable), highlighters, loose leaf paper (no graph paper)

Christian Studies 10- Bible (NIV or ESV), Small 2/4 ring binder (2nd semester), Journal (Small Tesco style is suitable), loose leaf paper (no graph paper) Color pencils & a highlighter

Christian Studies 11- Bible (any version), Medium 2 or 4 ring binder, loose leaf paper

Christian Studies 12- Bible (NIV or ESV), medium 2 or 4 ring binder, journal (Small Tesco style is suitable), loose leaf paper (no graph paper), color pencils and a highlighter
Civics - One 2 or 4 ring binder notebook, tissue box

Civics- One 2 or 4 ring binder, notebook and 1 tissue box

Communications 12- One section of a binder, or any notebook that can be used only for class (incl. paper for note-taking, pockets or folder for handouts), a package of straight-edge, lined notebook paper, red or colorful pens (for grading), blue/black pens (for other writing). If

possible: one box of tissues AND comics, articles, or pictures related to communications, literature, or writing.

Discrete Math- Pencils, loose-leaf paper (either blank, lined or graph) or a math notebook, 4 ring binder or folder

Economics/World Problems- Binder, blank notebook paper, journal (A4 size Notebook), pen/pencil

ELL- 1 small notebook for journal entries, lined A4 size paper, pencils, pens, pencil eraser

English 9-One 2 or 4-ring binder with three dividers and lined, straight-edged A4 paper, blue and black pens for homework and notes, “fun” colored pen such as purple, orange, green, or red (for grading and projects only), markers or colored pencils, Summer Reading Log, one box of tissues, favorite book recommendation, book cover

English 10 –World Literature -One section of a binder, or any notebook that can be used only for class (incl. paper for note-taking, pockets or folder for handouts), a package of straight-edge, lined notebook paper, red or colorful pens (for grading), blue/black pens (for other writing), and your 2 Reading Logs from Summer Reading Program. If possible: one box of tissues AND comics, articles, or pictures related to grammar, literature, or writing.

English 11 American Literature & American Literature Fundamentals_- One section of a binder, or any notebook that can be used only for class (incl. paper for note-taking, pockets or folder for handouts), a package of straight-edge, lined notebook paper, red or colorful pens (for grading), blue/black pens (for other writing), and your 2 Reading Logs from Summer Reading Program. If possible: one box of tissues AND comics, articles, or pictures related to grammar, literature, or writing.

English 12 British Literature- One two- or four-ring binder with three dividers and lined, straight-edged A4 paper, blue and or black pens for homework and notes, “fun” colored pen such as purple, green, or red (for grading and projects only), Summer Reading Logs, one box of tissues, favorite book recommendation, book cover

Senior English (for those students not in British Lit)- One section of a binder, or any notebook that can be used only for class (incl. paper for note-taking, pockets or folder for handouts), a package of straight-edge, lined notebook paper, red or colorful pens (for grading), blue/black pens (for other writing), and your 2 Reading Logs from Summer Reading Program. If possible: one box of tissues AND comics, articles, or pictures related to grammar, literature, or writing.

Fundamentals of English 9 & 10_- One section of a binder, or any notebook that can be used only for class (incl. paper for note-taking, pockets or folder for handouts), a package of straight-edge, lined notebook paper, red or colorful pens (for grading), blue/black pens (for other writing), and your 2 Reading Logs from Summer Reading Program. If possible: one box of tissues.

Geometry - Pencil, erasers, one 2 or 4-ring binder with loose-leaf graphing paper size A4 (can be the smaller binder), dividers for the binder, scientific calculator (preferably with a 2-row display), ruler, protractor, compass, pencils

German 1 & 2- Two A4 or A5 lined notebooks, folder, green pen

German 3- A4 ring binder with 4 dividers, 2 green pens for in-class grading, 2 packages of lined A4 paper.

HS Choir- Girls: Black skirt – knee length, white blouse with collar (no sleeveless shirts) Boys: Black dress trousers, black shoes, white button front dress shirt

HS Band-Girls: Black skirt – knee length, white blouse with collar (no sleeveless shirts) Boys: Black dress trousers, black shoes, white button front dress shirt

Journalism- Two small notebooks or tablets (one for class notes, and one to take on interviews), pen. If possible, one or two newspapers in English and comics, articles, or pictures related to journalism, literature, or writing.

P.E.- Separate pair of athletic shoes (rubber non-marking soled shoes), athletic shorts (that meet dress code---not too short) or sweat pants, athletic t-shirt

Personal Finance- A section in a 2 or 4 ring binder, pens/pencils

Physical Science- One 2- or 4-ring binder, calculator recommended but not required, ruler, one pack college-ruled paper, color pencils

Physics- Scientific calculator (does not need to be a graphing calculator), one 2- or 4-ring binder, colored pencils, #2 pencils, 1 pack college-ruled paper, note cards (not required but recommended)

Pre-Calculus-One 2 or 4-ring binder with loose-leaf paper, pencils, personal TI Inspire graphing calculator REQUIRED.

Social Studies 11- Blue or black pens, a package of lined paper, color pencils, binder

Social Studies 12- Binder; dividers; journal/notebook

Spanish I & II- Spanish-English dictionary, folder for handouts & worksheets, notebook

Study Skills: Planner/Assignment notebook, notebook, pen and pencil

US History 9- One 2 or 4 ring binder, notebook, color pencils

US History 10- One 2 or 4 ring binder, notebook, color pencils

Western Civilizations II- One 2 or 4 ring binder, notebook, color pencils

World History- Binder, blank notebook paper, pen and pencil

Yearbook- A package of lined paper
