**SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED INFECTIONS (STI) AND PREGNANCY
PREVENTION EDUCATION POLICY**

It is the policy of the Barre Unified Union School District (B.U.U.S.D.) to provide a Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI) and pregnancy prevention education program that is integrated into the health curriculum of the B.U.U.S.D.

One component of this program is to make available latex condoms (or other protective barrier options as they become available) in schools in an age appropriate manner. Parents or guardians of B.U.U.S.D. students can, upon request, withhold permission for their child's participation in the condom availability component of the program. The Principal or designee in each building will develop procedures for condom availability and distribution, based on the recommendation of the SHAC Committee in accordance with the policy set forth here..
